

New Dog-friendly Exercise Area

As part of plans to improve Beacon Field, we have fenced-off part of the field as a dog-friendly exercise area. Anyone with a boisterous or nervous dog can exercise it there, knowing that it will not cause a problem for other users of the field, such as parents with younger children. We would also suggest that dog-owners use this area at times when the field is particularly busy, such as school holidays and weekends.

In keeping with our support for the Woodland Trust's "Tree Charter", which encourages an annual tree-planting event, we are aiming to plant a native Dog Rose hedge, along the line of the fence, to create an attractive natural barrier.

Making the most of Winter Grit Supplies

Our Caretaker will be re-filling the green Parish Council grit bins over the next few weeks.

It costs the Parish Council approximately £80 every time the grit bin is re-filled, so please use the grit sparingly - just **one tablespoon is enough to treat one square metre**, and using more salt doesn't have a greater effect.

Exciting Project Ideas for Next Year

The Parish Council is meeting in early December to discuss the budget and projects for next year. This will be followed by a budget-setting meeting in January. Listed below are some of the projects that have been suggested:

- Water fountain/bottle filling stations on the Recreation Ground and Beacon Field;
- Festive Lights on Orchard Way;
- 'Philosophers' quiet outside seating area at Beacon Field/Beacon Hall;
- Creation of an accessible allotment plot at Braysdown Allotments for use by those with disabilities;
- Additional meeting rooms and storage at Beacon Hall;
- Outdoor/Adult Gym Equipment at Beacon Field;
- Recreation Ground Footpath Extension to create a footpath that runs the length of the Recreation Ground;
- Coal mining cart planters for floral displays.
