<p>C083 – 27/01/2026 Correspondence, Complaints & Issues To review items of significant correspondence, complaints and issues received since the last meeting that should be brought to the Council's attention for information and possible future action.</p> <p>Some issues raised regarding the bund clearance at the back of Westbury View: Some residents have complained about the clearance accusing the council of having no regard for wild-life – although others have complained that the work has not gone far enough and would like to see further clearance due to interrupted light transmission into their properties or lack of view. Some residents complained that they were not fully informed and that the notice should have been more widely circulated. – this has been noted by the office for any future works.</p> <p>Complaint received regarding width of pavement outside 2 Bath Road. I have responded to resident explaining this is a matter for highways – resident feels Council should have a voice to represent Peasedown residents' interests.</p> <p>Complaint regarding the sparseness of Christmas lights and lack of impact. This is to be considered by the Christmas Tree lights group when planning the display for the next three years.</p> <p>Complaint regarding the placement of a Christmas motif. This was incorrectly placed by Volker, who were asked to move it and failed to do this.</p> <p>Streetlight C10 on Church Road is still not working despite Volker informing us twice they would come and sort it under warranty. Resident has complained that the lack of streetlight makes it difficult to pull out of drive at this time of year and difficult for older residents or people who may have a visual difficulty to use the pathway at this time of year.</p>	<p>10 min 9.25pm</p>
